Regular Members include vendor management companies, title underwriters, title agencies, appraisal companies, law firms, flood determination providers, credit reporting companies, title examiners, notaries, abstractors, and other settlement service companies providing either 1) multiple settlement services in one or more state(s), or, 2) a single settlement service in multiple states.

Associate Memberships are available to any individual, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, business firm or other entity providing ancillary services (computer technology, telecommunications, consulting services, for example), to vendor management companies, title underwriters, title agencies, appraisal companies, law firms, flood determination providers, credit reporting companies, title examiners, notaries, abstractors, and other settlement service companies.

Affiliate Memberships are available to appraisers, title examiners, notaries, abstractors, and other settlement service companies in a single metropolitan statistical area (MSA) of a single state. Affiliate Membership is not available to any entity meeting the Regular, Associate or Industry Advisory Member criteria.

Industry Advisory Memberships are available to lending institutions and others that utilize vendor management and settlement services.
